SUPPLEMENTAL SEARCH WARRANT

TO: Any member of the New York State Police and Brian F. Chase, (Action under the supervision of the New York State Police):

IT APPEARING from the application of New York State Police Senior Investigator Albro Francher that a criminal investigation is being conducted relating to a limousine (the "Subject Vehicle") involved in a fatal motor vehicle crash at the intersection of State Routes 30 and 30A in the Town of Schoharie, County of Schoharie, State of New York that caused the deaths of 20 people.

And based upon the application, this Court determines that there is probable cause to believe that additional property and information relevant to the cause and circumstances of the crash may be found within the transmission and torque converter of the Subject Vehicle and constitutes evidence or tends to demonstrate that an offense has been committed in this state or that a particular person

participated in the commission of an offense in this state and specific and articulable facts have been shown that there is probable cause to believe that the evidence sought is relevant and material to an ongoing criminal investigation,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED, that you are directed to search, remove, disassemble and inspect the transmission and torque converter of the Subject Vehicle and transport the transmission and torque converter to Brian F. Chase, and it is further,

ORDERED, that any property or evidence or any part thereof, be seized, retained and stored by the New York State Police or Brian F. Chase, Certified Master Automotive Technician, Crash Reconstruction expert and Vehicle Dynamics expert, under the supervision of the New York State Police **pursuant to the conditions of the stipulation placed on the Court record on January 29, 2019 between the Schoharie County District Attorney, New York State Police, Defendant, Nauman Hussain, and the National Traffic Safety Board; or as directed by the Court pursuant to CPL §690.55.**

ORDERED, that under its supervision, the New York State Police may utilize the assistance of Brian F. Chase in inspecting and analyzing any and all property recovered; and it is further

ORDERED, that this warrant may be executed at any time of the day or night; and it is further

ORDERED, that the persons involved in the search are authorized to record and document the process involved in executing this search warrant, which will include, but is not limited to, photography, video, sketches and

narrative descriptions while collecting, marking and packaging any and all physical evidence.
