Oral application being made by the above captioned petitioners before this Court on November 8, 2022, at a Special Election Term of this Court, sitting for the day of Election, and appearances and argument being taken on the application from the petitioners as well as the County Attorney on behalf of the Washington County Board of Elections, and counsel for the New York State Board of Elections, due deliberation being had thereon, it is hereby:

emergency ballots cast in Washington County, the Town of Granville election districts 1, 2, and 3 and the Town of Fort Edward election districts 3 and 4 that were transported from their polling places (Village Municipal Building and the School of Burgoyne, respectively) to the Washington County Board of Elections (383 Broadway, Fort Edward, New York) solely by Commissioner Jeffrey Curtis shall be segregated from other ballots, canvassed and added to the vote tallies for candidates and be maintained by the Washington County Board of Elections and also be counted

as separate ballots with a separate tally within their respective election district and preserved for further review and reconciliation, and it is further

ORDERED, on November 8, 2022, that emergency ballots from the Town of Argyle election districts 1, 2, and 3 and the Town of Cambridge election districts 1 and 2, the Town of Dresden election district 1, the Town of Easton election districts 1 and 2, the Town of Fort Ann election districts 1, 2, and 3, the Town of Fort Edward election districts 1, 2 and 5 and the Town of Granville election districts 4 and 5 shall be delivered from their polling places in sealed bags and in a bipartisan manner to the Washington County Board of Elections for canvassing by computer scanning, and it is further

ORDERED, that a true copy of this Order shall be served upon the Commissioners of Elections at the offices thereof or upon the County Attorney, and upon the New York State Board of Elections by electronic transmission to such Board, on November 8, 2022, and that such service shall be good and sufficient service thereof, and it is

ORDERED, that the County Attorney shall cause a true copy of this Order to be filed with the County Clerk in the manner in which Election Day Orders affecting voters are filed.
