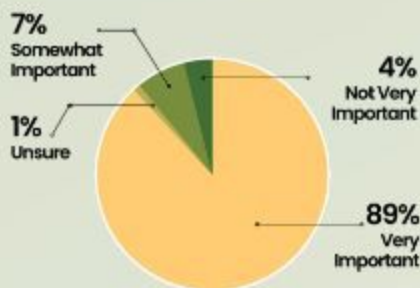

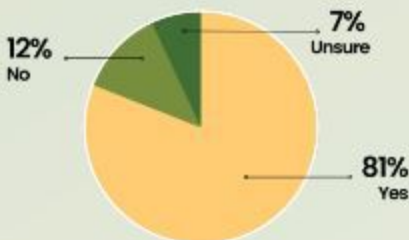
QUESTION 1

Do you believe the issue of cell phone service in the Adirondack Park is:



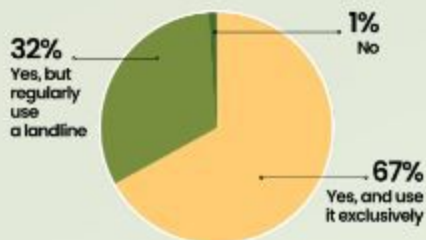
QUESTION 3

QUESTION 5

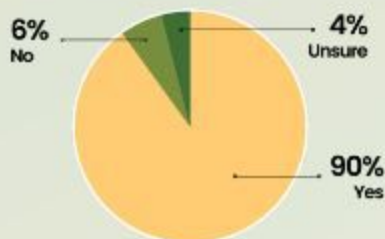
Do you own a cell phone?
